

# TALK OF THE TRADE



#### Technology Improves Residential Fire Sprinkler Reliability

#### Myth: If one sprinkler goes off, they all go off.

Fact: Unlike scenes from Hollywood movies, sprinklers activate independently and only the sprinkler closest to the fire will spray water.

#### Myth: Sprinklers will leak.

Fact: Home sprinkler systems are just as reliable as the other plumbing systems in our homes.

#### Myth: Water damage from sprinklers is worse than fire damage.

Fact: The property loss in a sprinklered home fire is a small fraction of the typical loss in an unsprinklered home where a fire can spread much faster and cause substantial heat and smoke damage throughout the entire home.

#### Myth: Sprinklers will freeze in winter.

Fact: The national installation standard provides guidance for proper installation in cold regions. Home sprinklers piping is protected from freezing just as other home plumbing pipes are.

#### Myth: I have smoke alarms so I don't need fire sprinklers.

Fact: Smoke alarms are essential in every home. But they can only detect smoke. Fire sprinklers detect the fire and automatically control it.
