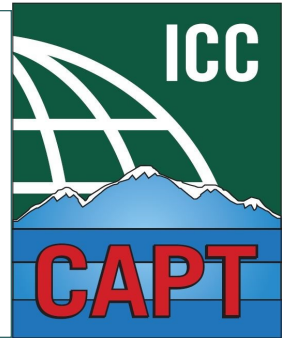

Chapter 3 of the 2015 IRC - PART II

Presented by Glenn Mathewson

Part I was presented at the November meeting hosted by the Town of Parker. Building Planning—how to provide the necessary criteria for the design and construction of homes. This section is critical for design parameters such as geographic criteria, minimum room sizes, and construction geometry in features like stairways and guards. Chapter 3 sets the general requirements for how a home must be built for the safe use and navigation of the occupants and must be understood prior to applying the more specific code provisions in the following chapters. Learn or refresh the basics of home design in this unique course that covers all the sections of Chapter 3, some in depth and some with a general overview.

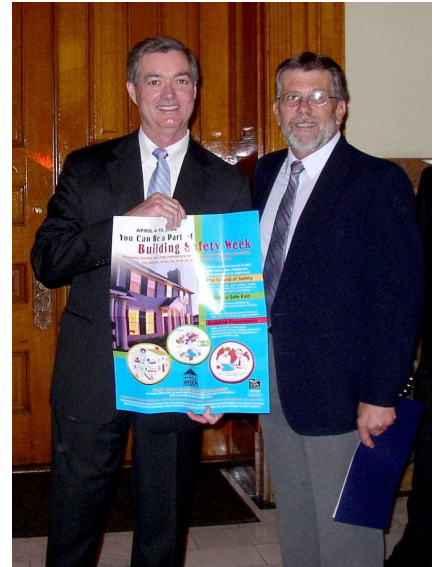

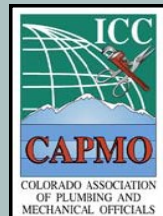
